Athlete Performance Pathways A précis

This paper summarises the Athlete Performance Pathways (APP) document which is restricted to members of the Scottish Smallbore Rifle Association. Copies will also be made available to affiliated clubs on request.

The Athlete Performance Pathways document describes in detail all that smallbore target shooters need to know if they aspire to represent Scotland in International competition, whether at NSRA National Meetings or at ISSF events, and also touches upon Great Britain representation.

If you are not a member, please consider joining the Association to obtain your own copy. Please also draw this information to the attention of your club colleagues.

The Athlete Performance Pathways document describes

- the organisation of the SSRA squads
- the requirements for joining them
- the conditions of squad membership
- squad guideline selection standards
- the administration that supports the squads
- the coaching structure.

ISSF International and NSRA International pathways are both set out, though they are not mutually exclusive.

The A, U25, B and Junior squads integrate to form the foundation for shooters aspiring to ISSF International honours and the APP document sets out the aims of these squads. Membership of these squads will be revised annually. Anyone wishing to join the squads should submit an application and a proforma is available in the APP document.

The NSRA International pathway section sets out the way to representing Scotland in matches shot under NSRA conditions and includes the aims of the National squad which will address this development route. It also includes the selection policy for Home Countries International Matches at Scottish and British National Meetings.

This is an important document and it belongs on every shooter's reference shelf beside his rule books.
