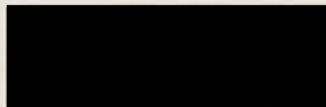

Performance in all the squadded competitions at St. Andrews (including the Haig qualifying) will figure prominently in selection consideration.

Squad membership gives you opportunities for match experience beyond the National meetings. This requires cash and the Match Fund is the medium for fundraising and disbursement. The Race Night at St. Andrews on Tuesday, 26th June, is aiming to add at least £600 to the kitty. It needs your support:-

(a) to promote and attend the function,

and (b) especially, to gather in donations to the eight prize lists from club colleagues and relevant local businesses.
