1981 FINAL TRIALS

Denwood on Sunday, 17th May

Location

Denwood is on the south west corner of Hazelhead Park, Aberdeen, and access is off Countesswells Road. It is on the right hand side (past nursery gardens) with the entrance directly opposite a large water reservoir dome.

Programme

- (A) 12 noon - 1.00 p.m. 40 shots at 50 metres
- (B) 2.00 p.m. - 3.00 p.m. Dewar Course
- (C) 4.00 p.m. - 5.00 p.m. 40 shots at 100 yards

The programme has been divided into three sessions to equalise range advantages.

Ladies' & Juniors' Trial/Training:-

- 1.00 p.m. - 2.00 p.m. 40 shots at 50 metres
- 3.00 p.m. - 4.00 p.m. 40 shots at 100 yards

The range will be open for two practice details at 10.45 and 11.15 a.m., price 10p per card.

Fees

For other than the postal trialists the charge will be 60 pence (if Individual Members) or 80 pence (if Club Members).

Squadding

The trial will be squadded and each shooter will draw for his/her firing positions on arrival. I would greatly appreciate prior notification of anyone unable to attend (phone [redacted], leave message if I am absent).

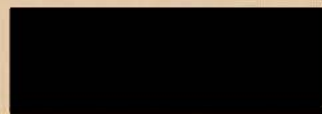
