1982 FINAL TRIALS

Denwood on Sunday, 16th May

Location

Denwood is on the south west corner of Hazelhead Park, Aberdeen, and access is off Countesswells Road. It is on the right hand side (past nursery gardens) with the entrance directly opposite a large water reservoir dome.

Programme

- (A) 12 noon - 1.00 p.m. 40 shots at 50 metres
- (B) 2.00 p.m. - 3.00 p.m. Dewar Course
- (C) 4.00 p.m. - 5.00 p.m. 40 shots at 100 yards

The programme has been divided into three sessions to equalise range advantages.

Ladies' & Juniors' Trial/Training:-

- 1.00 p.m. - 2.00 p.m. 40 shots at 50 metres
- 3.00 p.m. - 4.00 p.m. 40 shots at 100 yards

The range will be open for two practice details at 10.30 and 11.00 a.m., price 10p per card.

Those qualifying on Sunday will be asked to confirm their availability for the match with the British Army (near Aldershot) on 21st/22nd August and advise on their intentions for the Scottish (3rd/9th July) and Bisley (14th/21st August).

You are all reminded that we have won the Home Countries' trophy at the Scottish for the past three years and a large attendance of all candidates at both meetings is sought.
