1984 FINAL TRIALS

Denwood on Saturday, 2nd June

Location

Denwood is on the south west corner of Hazelhead Park, Aberdeen, and access is off Countesswells Road. It is on the right hand side (past nursery gardens) with the entrance directly opposite a large water reservoir dome.

Programme

- (A) 12 noon - 1.00 p.m. 40 shots at 50 metres
- (B) 2.00 p.m. - 3.00 p.m. Dewar Course
- (C) 4.00 p.m. - 5.00 p.m. 40 shots at 100 yards

The programme has been divided into three sessions to equalise range advantages.

Ladies' & Juniors' Trial/Training:-

- 1.00 p.m. - 2.00 p.m. 40 shots at 50 metres
- 3.00 p.m. - 4.00 p.m. 40 shots at 100 yards

The range will be open for two practice details at 10.30 and 11.00 a.m., price 20p per card.

Squadding

The trial will be squadded and the draw will be made during the second practice detail. I would greatly appreciate prior notification of anyone unable to attend (phone [REDACTED] leave message if I am absent).

1984 Team Squad

## Squad Training Arrangements

All members of the Senior Squad are invited to assemble in the Squad Tent at the Scottish on Saturday, 23rd June, at 3 p.m. The plan is to have each member shoot 2 details at 100 yards, under general supervision, probably between 4 p.m. and 5 p.m. Geoff Webb and I shall be present to observe points for later discussion and to answer any technical or administrative queries. You are also urged to enter the Squaddled Non-Aggregate Dewar (competition 6).

This arrangement has been determined for two reasons, (i) in recent years we have tended to lose matches at 100 yards after a good start at the 50's, and (ii) it has become apparent that those who had a prior competitive shoot (the Squaddled Non-Aggregate Dewar) fared much better in the Haig Qualifying than those for whom the Haig was the first blow in anger. Ignominiously, three years ago, only three of that year's Team Squad qualified for the Haig Final!

The Ladies and Junior Aberdeen trialists are similarly invited to take part in the afternoon session. Geoff will then probably arrange a separate meeting to discuss his observations.
