Team Squad Trials for 1985

At a recent Council Meeting it was decided that Dr. Harry Milne, Bon Accord, be appointed Chief Coach for the senior squad. Dr. Geoff Webb will continue to run the successful junior squad within a national coaching programme expanded to give regional coverage. Bob Normand remains as Team Manager for the time being. The principal objectives are to produce top Scottish performances at the Commonwealth Games 1986 and to add new zest to all Scottish team performances after a lean spell.

The core of the 1985 Prone Squad is being assembled NOW in order that they may undertake a winter programme of training and coaching. A selection trial will therefore be held at Denwood on Sunday, 7th October, 1984, to select exactly 10 members to join those Scots in the National Senior Squads (A.M. Allan, W.J. Macneil, J.N. Knowles) and any of the representatives in the Mini-Games prone event in Jersey who win a medal. Parallel programmes for 3-Position and Air Rifle are under consideration.

The Denwood course of fire will comprise 60 shots at 50 metres and 60 shots at 100 yards. Those invited to take part will be the 1984 Squad (please advise if not attending) and the top 10 in a new postal trial (Double Dewar). In view of the short time available, stickers are being issued without application to all who took part in the earlier 1984 postal trial and to others thought to be interested. Any other Scots may take part on application to the Secretary; write or phone. Entry fee is £1, payable either on application or with return of the shot cards. Only candidates prepared to follow the winter training programme should take part.

There will be a fresh opportunity to join the Team Squad during the 1985 outdoor season when a system of "nominating shoots" will be introduced. Details will be announced in one of the winter newsletters.

The postal trial will serve the second purpose of allowing a Junior Squad to be similarly assembled in preparation for the annual Lancashire match in April, 1985. A Junior will be any shooter under the age of 21 years on 30th April, 1985. It is hoped that the top 10 Juniors in the postal trial can be invited to shoot a training "match" at Denwood also on 7th October, 1984. Please beat the bushes to make sure no reasonable candidate misses the opportunity.


